Participants will conduct a "Collegiate" Debate using a modified Oxford Debate Schedule. They will respectfully request that the audience remain seated and in good order including conforming to the following;

Audience Rules: Quiet, please. No Applause until the end of debate. No Verbal outbursts. No Profanity. Moderator will warn those who are out of order one time. The debate will be stopped until the offender has been removed. *In the event of repeated interruptions, debate will be terminated.*

Audience participation and **Q&A session** will be structured Moderated Q&A wherein audience participants submit written questions that read in less than 30 seconds which can be directed to either or both of the Affirmative, or Negative answers.

UNCG Debate Format (9-2-2010)

Introduction for both parties by moderator: 1 minute total.

Opening affirmative, 16 minutes.

Opening negative 16 minutes.

1st Cross-Exam: Affirmative questions negative, 8 minutes.

2nd Cross-Exam: Negative questions affirmative, 8 minutes.

Rebuttal Affirmative, 6 minutes.

Rebuttal Negative, 6 minutes.

5 minute break – A & N are given time to prepare their closing statements while audience submits written questions on 3x5 index card, bathroom break, etc.

Affirmative summation, 6 minutes.

Negative summation, 6 minutes.

Audience Questions, 20 minutes - Moderator alternates questions between A & N and identifies which team member (if any) is addressed.

Moderator closing comments, dismissal, and applause - 1 minute.
